

This is the third mystery novel starring Gemma Rose and her cute little Tabby, Muesli. Gemma owns and operates a quaint little tearoom in Oxford, and although she tries to live a quiet life, she always manages to stumble across a dead body, and the police always arrest the wrong person. In order to clear the innocent person who is wrongly accused, Gemma is drawn into doing some sleuthing on her own. When an old friend and former schoolmate (Seth Browning) is accused of murdering a colleague at Wadsworth College, the evidence piles up against him, since he was the one that was found standing over the dead body with a bloody dagger in his hand. Detective Devin O'Connor, one of Gemma's suitors, is leading the homicide investigation, but Gemma does some investigating on her own, and for the sake of helping her friend beat the murder rap, she holds back evidence from the police, which, as expected, does not sit well with the detective. It soon becomes obvious that the dead man, Professor Barrow, was an arrogant and heartless man who wasn't liked by anybody, and although Seth is the one who is in the hot seat, there were a lot of other people who hated Professor Barrow enough to kill him if given the chance. Who was really the killer? Seth? Professor Barrow's sister? One of his own colleagues at the college? The porter at the cloisters? The homeless man who was seen loitering across the street from the college campus? And how did they get into Wadsworth, when it is locked at night? As the story proceeds, we will also be meeting a few new characters who also have plenty of motive to kill Professor Barrow. You won't figure out who the killer is until the very end.
