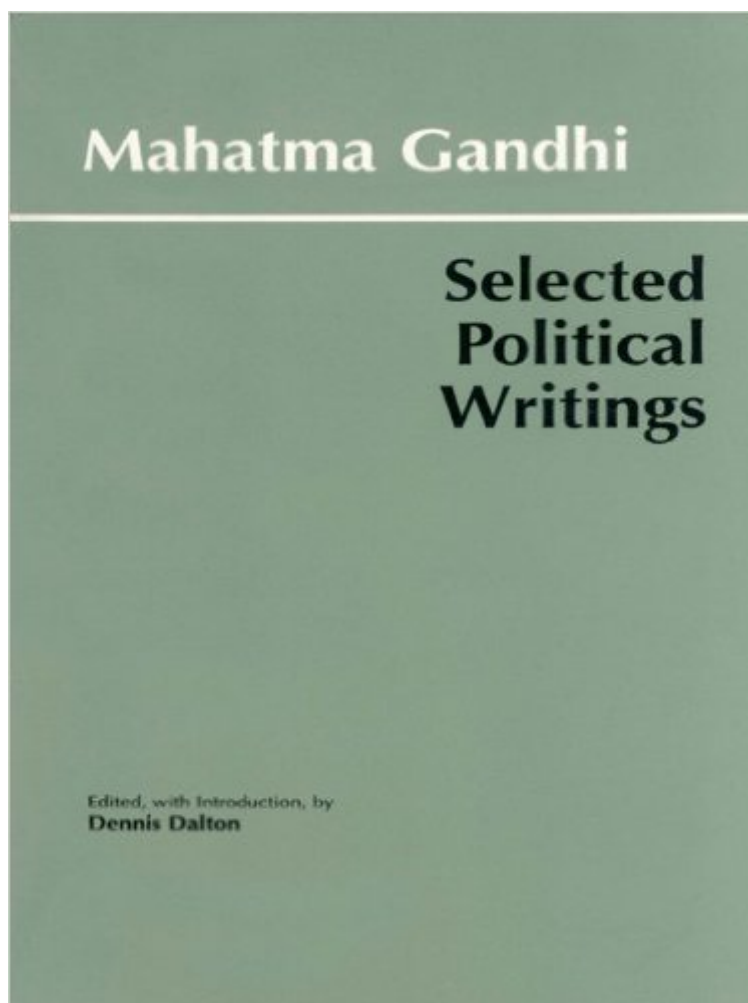


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Selected Political Writings (Hackett Classics)

Dennis Dalton, editor, is a Gandhi scholar and professor of political science. This collection of Gandhi's political writing is the best introduction to Gandhi's thinking that I have found. Professor Dalton's Introduction and the structuring of the writings quickly give the reader a framework in which Gandhi's life and work can be clearly comprehended.

This is one of my favorite books. It is an excellent collection of Gandhi's political writings from when he returned to India. However, the writings also give a good insight into Gandhi's spiritual beliefs and thoughts on God. If you have always been curious about Gandhi's life and how he developed his philosophy of Satyagraha and Swaraj, the foreword provides a brief but thorough

exploration of his life leading up to his return to India, including his time in England and South Africa. Each selected writing also has a short introduction that gives the context of the time and circumstances that preceded the letter or writing. I highly recommend this book for people of all ages.
