

An nice addition to the first book 'Charlie's Requiem'. As Charlie, Janice, Garrett and Brie hide in a ready-made DHS apartment, they try to plan for their further travels to Janice's sister place....away from the city and the new dangers that exist after the apocalypse. Dr. Kramer wants to get home to his wife and daughter, but dropping off his patients is his first priority. When he sees the lack of survival skills that so many have, he must help treat the sick and inform others of how to keep safe and healthy. John is starting his role as a DHS agent, but after rescuing Charlie's group (and helping them hide), he is beginning to doubt the "helpfulness" of the DHS. After all, why should people have

to hide from them? All of these characters have their own stories, adventures, and challenges as they try to survive after the EMP event in central Florida. This book was a good follow-up to Charlie's initial adventures and I liked the development of the other characters, too. Unfortunately, I can only give this four stars for some glaring editing problems that interrupt the fluidity of the story. But the premise is sound and it's definitely worth a read.

Basic premise is a bit of a stretch, but not really outrageous, considering the profound density of some people I've met. Even bright Dr Kramer seems fairly dense to action in his surroundings. I'm looking forward to the next installment

I finished this up this morning and I have to say it is fantastic. The authors have balanced providing more info about the world of the Going Home series with not going overboard and giving it all away too soon. The cast of characters is growing but is not too unwieldy. We are also finding out more about characters introduced in the first volume. Some have made it home while others still have far to go. As with the original I have been tracking their travels using online maps so that I have a better idea of the ground that they are covering. This is a great addition to the overall series. I really love the big picture aspect and the view from within the belly of the beast. I am already impatient for the next in the series.

Both Charlie books are excellent. The plot is well thought out. There are twists that take you by surprise. The characters are so well developed that you feel as if you know them. A believable story.

The story line is credible and the characters are consistent, but the editing is poor, so it appears that the author is a poor speller and a poor proofreader. The difference between vicious and viscous is a game changer!

I thoroughly enjoyed the going home series but wondered what a more urban collapse might look like. This series had my devotion after I had finished the novella "Charlie's Requiem". I love the character development and can't wait for the next installment.
